Defibrillator

There is a Defibrillator on the wall of the Village Hall, Mill Lane, Leeming.

Defibrillation is a common treatment for life-threatening cardiac dysrhythmias and

ventricular fibrillation. **Defibrillation** consists of delivering a therapeutic dose of electrical energy to the heart with a device called a **defibrillator**.



Full instructions are displayed on the casing and anyone can use this life saving equipment in the event of an emergency.

Dog Fouling

There are many responsible dog walkers who pick up after their dogs and use the many bins located around the villages.

Thank you—you know who you are and we appreciate it. If you are one of those people who don't pick up after your dog, please read on:

TOXOCARIASIS – the disease transmitted by the worm larvae in dog faeces, picked up from contaminated soil. The disease can result in mild symptoms such as:

A cough, fever, headache and stomach pains. In severe cases the disease can attack the lungs, liver, eyes or brain and lead to irreversible damage.

Please, please pick up and dispose of dog faeces. Not only can it be dangerous but it also spoils this lovely area we live in.
