NYCC have now accepted that they own the bridge. The clerk was asked to push forward with NYCC. All were in favour.

c Policies

d Tennis courts – white paint

Cllr Naylor informed the meeting that he is hoping to get this done next week.

e Tree in main river

It was discussed that two trees are now in the river. The clerk was asked to chase up.

f Flooding – Priory Park/junction near bridge, roadway washed away

Cllr Williamson informed the meeting that the road is still washed away. The clerk was asked to chase this up.

g Priory Park – Paths

It was unsure whether this work had been done. Cllrs to check.

h SBC – Welcome Back Funding

The council had been successful in obtaining the funding to improve the sports facilities. Permission required from the Cricket Club and Tennis Courts prior to placing the order.
