7.1 NYM/2014/0505/MEIA Land at Woodsmith Mine (formerly known as Dove's Nest Farm and Haxby Plantation), Sneatonthorpe (proposed mine head); underneath 252 sq km of the NYMNPA (winning and working of materials); a corridor extending underground from the edge of the NP boundary to Wilton International complex (mineral transport system); Ladycross Plantation near Egton, Lockwood Beck Farm near Moorsholm, Tocketts Lythe, near Guisborough (intermediate shaft sites); site within eastern limits of the Wilton International Complex, Teesside (tunnel portal) (Planning permission reference NYM/2014/0676/MEIA dated 19 October 2015). Application for variation of condition 5 of planning permission NYM/2014/0676/MEIA dated 19 October 2015 to allow minor material amendments relating to that part of the development at the Woodsmith Mine site (formerly known as Dove's Nest Farm and Haxby Plantation); including re-design of fore shafts and shaft construction methodology, changes to building layout and shaft access arrangements, revisions to construction and operational shaft platform levels, revision to location and layout of surface water attenuation ponds, revision to groundwater management arrangements and amendments to internal access road arrangements. Minor modifications application received. Approved subject to a Section 106 Agreement.
