 - Cllr A Robinson raised the following points of interest,
 - Council Tax to increase by £5 for Band D property

- Make car parking spaces bigger
- Increase charging points for electric cars
- New post – HDC Communication manager
- Sign Posts for Footpath from N.Y.M.N.P.
- Health and safety on Silton green spike on quoits pitch dangerous
- Defra consultation details had been distributed to farmers and landowners in the NYM national park
- Mrs S Haynes would like a working party to plant spring flowers e.g. snow drops on west end of Nether Silton green
- NYMNP – Glover review which will include areas outside the national park there will be no boundary reviews but new areas of AONB
- Broadband – no progress with BT
- Nether Silton – Clerk asked to enquire if there was a fund which PC could apply to underground power lines through village.
- Finally Mrs Sarah Haynes agreed to take over as Parish Clerk from Kathryn Clark at the beginning of the next financial year.
