Defibrillator The meeting then welcomed Stuart Mountford from Thirsk Community 1st Responders and more members of the public from the bar area, to demonstrate the defibrillator, the meeting was very impressed with the way these machines worked and talked people through the use, they seemed very easy to use.

It was decided that as a parish we should explore getting 2 machines one for Nether Silton and one for Kepwick with the possibility of a 3rd one in the near future in Over Silton.

Stuart Mountford said these machines were offered to local communities free of charge but a donation would be appreciated to help buy more for stock. Electric would cost approx. £1 per month

Lieutic Would cost approx. 21 per

New sets of pads are £25

The machines come with 2 sets plus 2 toolkits which include, Razor blades, cloth for removing moisture tough cut scissors and a CPR face mask.

Stuart also said he was trained to provide 1st aid training to as many people who would like to attend for £125 for 2hrs.
